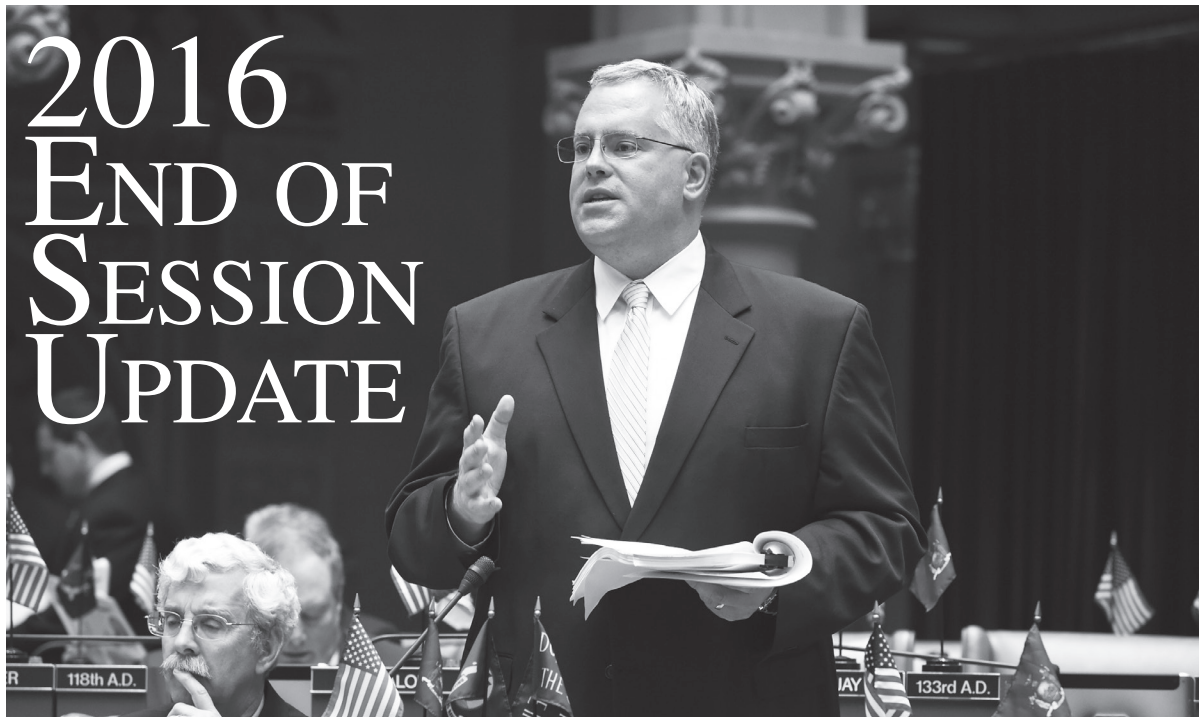


2016 END OF SESSION UPDATE

A BRIEF RECAP OF THE END OF SESSION

This year, Assemblyman Stec's leadership was invaluable in passing two Constitutional Amendments, among a number of other legislative measures. The following list includes a brief description of laws that are of particular importance to his constituents:

- Ethics reform that strips pensions and retirement benefits from corrupt officials who abuse the public's trust. Constitutional Amendment A10739 must pass again next year to be brought to the voters by 2017.
- Simplify and streamline the process for local governments to address public needs in their municipalities. As Ranking Minority Member of the Assembly Environmental Conservation Committee, Stec worked with the Chairman to ensure that A10721 passed, so Adirondack local governments can meet needs more efficiently.
- Heroin and Opioid Legislation (A10727); The Assembly Minority Conference held forums across the state, which aided in producing several legislative measures to help combat this growing epidemic.
- Veterans' Buyback Bill (A8174); Grants up to three years of service credit to all veterans of the state retirement system who were honorably discharged. Despite previously vetoing this measure, the Governor signed this into law this session. Stec was a strong advocate for this legislation.
- Testing for Lead in Schools (A10740); Tests drinking water in schools, requires reporting and remediation to ensure water is clean and safe.
