The 2017-18 New York State Budget secured the following initiatives:



\$2.5 billion for the Clean Water Infrastructure Act, repairing and replacing outdated faulty pipes, waste water systems and ensuring clean drinking water in our schools and homes.



\$300 million for the Environmental Protection Fund.



Restored Library Aid Funding for a total of \$95.6 million.



Increased Foundation Aid for our public schools by \$700 million, making sure our students receive a proper education.



Secured the Direct Care Worker Wage Adjustment, providing \$55 million in funding to our direct-care workers so they can receive an adequate and livable wage.
