BRIAN KOLB: Real Leadership, Smart Solutions for a Better New York

Here's what Brian Kolb has delivered: **FISCAL ACCOUNTABILITY, RESPONSIBLE BUDGETS**

- Enacted two consecutive on time State Budgets and the first early budget since 1983 – that cut Albany's wasteful spending and reduced State government's cost to taxpavers
- Closed \$13.5 billion in budget deficits over the past two years without increasing any broad-based State taxes, fees or surcharges
- Consolidated, eliminated or merged nearly 30 government entities to reduce State government's size and cost to taxpayers

TAX AND MANDATE RELIEF

- Opposed ALL tax, fee and surcharge increases, supported tax credits for businesses that hire unemployed workers and tax cuts to help families keep more of what they earn
- Enacted a 2% real property tax cap to help control the growth of local property taxes and provide relief to homeowners
- Required the State to begin a phased-in takeover of the increase in the local share of Medicaid to protect local governments and taxpavers

A STRONGER ECONOMY, SMART INVESTMENTS IN NEW YORK'S FUTURE

- Supported \$1 billion in funding to spur private sector job creation projects through the 10 Regional Economic Development Councils
- + Championed \$1.2 billion in "New York Works" transportation funding to pay for road and bridge repairs, created a "lock box" for mass transit dedicated funds to ensure money for road and bridge renovations is not misspent by Albany politicians
- Increased community college State Base Aid funding to \$2,272 per student, increased State aid to school districts by \$805 million, for a total of \$20.3 billion, the first State aid increase in the last 3 years



After years of dysfunction, gridlock and scandal, Albany is working again. New York State is finally heading in a positive, new direction - and Brian Kolb's leadership has made the difference!

Brian Kolb has delivered a more accountable and responsive state government along with the real change New Yorkers have demanded. However, Brian knows the job of fixing Albany is not finished – more work remains.
