Assemblymember Bronson helped create new women's equality laws



✓ Employers can no longer pay women less than men for comparable work because of their gender and workers can openly discuss their wages

✓ Stronger protections against workplace sexual harassment

✓ Ensures employers provide accommodations for women who are pregnant or nursing and aren't discriminating based on family status



✓ New protections from housing discrimination for victims of domestic violence

✓ Those who experience employment, credit or housing discrimination can recoup attorney fees

✓ A crackdown on human trafficking and its perpetrators

Assemblymember Bronson will keep fighting for women and families in New York State, starting with paid family leave and a livable wage for all.
