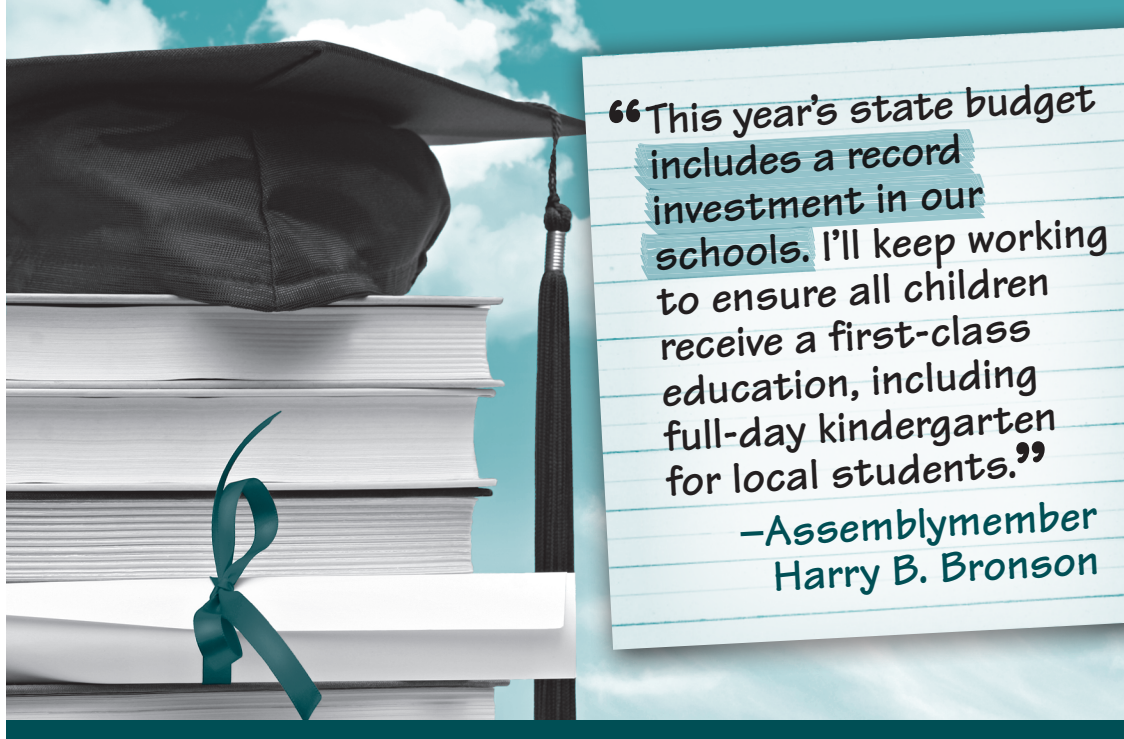


Assemblymember Bronson is fighting for our schools

Assemblymember Bronson secured a \$2 million increase in education aid for Rush-Henrietta schools

The 2016-17 state budget includes:

- ✓ \$32 million for Rush-Henrietta district schools, 6.81% more than last year
- ✓ \$807 million for pre-K education
- ✓ \$1 million for Career and Technical Education (CTE) – to break down barriers for English language learners and other students

- ✓ A freeze on SUNY tuition, so a 4-year college degree remains affordable
- ✓ \$23.8 million for opportunity programs, giving even more students a chance at success
