Securing a brighter future for our students

The 2022-23 state budget:

- Invests **\$31.2 billion** in total education aid, including a **\$1.5 billion** increase in Foundation Aid

- Invests **\$1.1 billion** in Universal Pre-Kindergarten, which is **\$125 million** above last year

- Provides **\$53 million** for school mental health programs to help students thrive in the classroom and beyond

- Provides nearly **\$3 billion** to increase access to quality, affordable child care

- Invests over **\$109 million** for arts and cultural institutions throughout NYS as they continue to rebuild and recover from the COVID-19 pandemic
