Helped Block the Governor's Plan to End Local Zoning*

Matt successfully helped block the Governor's proposal ending local control over zoning and requiring suburban towns to build thousands of new housing units, including high-rise apartment buildings in our downtown areas. This prevented potential overcrowding in our schools and higher school taxes.

Protecting Property Taxpayers

Matt also wrote legislation to stop the Governor's plan for the state to take hundreds of millions of dollars away from local governments. This would potentially stop property taxes from going up this year (A.6218). ¹

New York City's failed Right to Shelter policy forces taxpayers to spend billions supporting migrants arriving here. Assemblyman Slater is in the process of sponsoring legislation that restores common-sense to this policy and prevents New York City from using it to send migrants to the Hudson Valley. ²
