Local Highway Departments And Workers Need Resources And Support So They Can Work To Make Our Roads Safer, More Reliable And Long-Lasting.

I have supported efforts to:

- Honor our fallen heroes by designating State Route 372 in parts of Washington County as the “Deputy Chief Brian Buell Memorial Bridge” (A.3162) and a portion of Interstate Route 87 in parts of Albany County as the “General Colin Powell Thruway” (A.5149), and participating in an unveiling ceremony for the Lt. Col. William J. O’Brien and Sgt. Thomas A. Baker Memorial Highway.
- Enact the “Roadway Excavation Quality Assurance Act,” which would require utility companies seeking permits for street excavation projects to use competent skilled workers and pay them prevailing wages (A.5608).
