

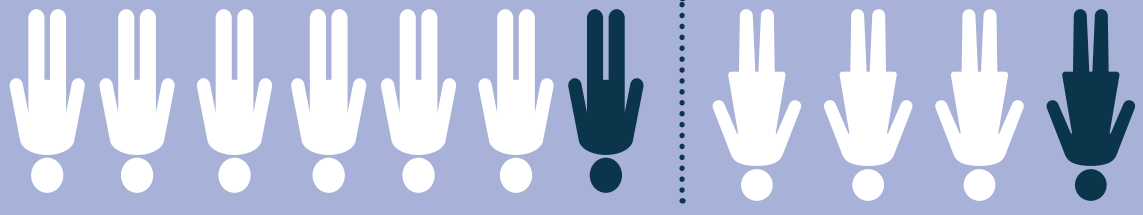

That's why I introduced new legislation: Named after Gabby Petito, the 22-year-old New Yorker whose tragic disappearance and eventual murder by her boyfriend captured the nation in 2022, "Gabby's Law" would streamline reporting of these cases and create a "Teal Alert" to increase awareness and the chance of recovery of missing persons and allow New York State to join an existing national alert program for missing persons (A.3230).
