

COMBATING EMERGING DRUG THREATS

We must stay ahead of new synthetic drugs before more lives are lost.

- ◆ A.5099 – Would add xylazine to New York’s controlled substances list
- ◆ A.9001 – Looks to establish a test strip program for harmful contaminants
- ◆ A.9287 – Would criminalize certain sales and possession of nitrous oxide

EXPANDING ACCESS TO LIFE-SAVING MEDICATION

When seconds matter, access to naloxone saves lives.

- ◆ A.7409 – Looks to ensure all FDA-approved forms of naloxone are recognized under state law

PROTECTING KIDS FROM VAPING

Our classrooms should be focused on learning, not addiction.

- ◆ A.2102 – Would prohibit vape products designed to resemble school supplies
- ◆ A.6534 – Seeks to require schools to implement vaping prevention programs

RESPONSIBLE PRESCRIBING & TRANSPARENCY

Prevention starts with informed decisions, and accountability matters

- ◆ A.6518 – Would require counseling about opioid addiction risks
- ◆ A.8997 – Would require public reporting on opioid settlement spending
