In 2019, the Legislature went full steam ahead with higher taxes, more spending, and softer punishments for suspected criminals.

Despite these challenges,

Assemblyman Dave McDonough has never stopped fighting for us and our values.

When the governor proposed slashing the budget for local libraries -

Dave fought back and restored the cuts. (2019 Executive Budget Proposal)

When legislators eliminated critical mental health services for our veterans -

Dave fought back and protected the Joseph P. Dwyer veteran counseling program. (A.2003-D)

And when legislators proposed \$5.7 billion in new taxes -

Dave voted against their harmful money grab. (Reso. E164)

- Voting rights for incarcerated felons (S.6821)*
- Taxpayer-funded political campaigns (A.2009-C)
