

LEGISLATION I ADVOCATED FOR THIS YEAR:

- Establishing a senior housing accessibility study group to make recommendations for enhancing accessibility requirements for all newly constructed senior housing developments (A.4169).
- Raising the income cap for senior citizens applying for the enhanced STAR property tax exemption to \$100,000 (A.2769).
- Establishing an Alzheimer's disease outreach and education program to promote earlier identification of Alzheimer's and to provide information and other assistance in finding community support for caregivers (A.1629).
- Suspending for two years the state's 4% sales tax on products that families rely on daily (A.1690).
