PASSING THE CO-OP AND CONDO ABATEMENT

One of the first major bills passed this year was landmark legislation to provide hundreds of thousands of New York City homeowners with significant property tax relief and create new affordable housing while spurring economic development. The bill expands New York City's Condominium and Cooperative real property tax abatement program by phasing out benefits to non-primary residences and spreading the benefit to hundreds of thousands of low and middle income homeowners. I am proud to have voted in favor of transferring savings to Queens' middle class families and seniors.
