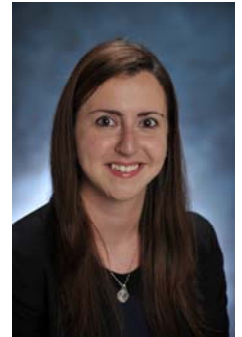

PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT WORKSHOP

Starting in January, homeowners will receive a "Notice of Property Value" from the NYC Department of Finance in the mail. These values are used by the NYC Department of Finance to determine the tax rate of a property. If owners believe their assessed values are not correct, they have until mid-March to challenge them with the NYC Tax Commission. My office is hosting representatives from the NYC Department of Finance and the NYC Tax Commission to help homeowners understand their property tax assessment and provide assistance.
