I will be rejoining the fray with lots of gratitude, a long to-do list, and a renewed sense of urgency for the work we do.

Over the last several months, I have loved every moment spent together nurturing my growing family. I would like to thank my team, and all of you, for your patience and grace as I have stepped away for a bit (though let's be honest I was never really gone!). I know there is plenty of work to be done and I am ready to get back to it.

# NEWS FROM OUR



### **Providing New State Funding For Schools**

This year, M.S. 74 Nathaniel Hawthorne received \$80,000 for their gymnasium safety equipment and scoreboard. P.S. 162 John Golden and P.S. 24 Andrew Jackson each received \$250,000 for substantial upgrades to their auditoriums, including updated stage areas and state-of-the-art sound systems. With students returning for another successful academic year, many were greeted with renovations that took place over the summer and others will notice changes in the coming months.

These funding allocations complement my announcements of other investments, including \$250,000 and \$120,000 respectively for technology upgrades to P.S. 154 in Fresh Meadows and P.S. 120 in Flushing. Additionally, I allocated \$30,000 for a new STEM lab at Schechter Queens. It is crucial to provide students with modern resources that contribute to their success both in and out of the classroom.



#### Having Fun with the Whole Family

In late August, I partnered with Commonpoint Queens to host my annual Family Fun Day at Cunningham Park, welcoming hundreds to enjoy a day filled with inflatables, face painting, snacks, and giveaways! We've been fortunate to have many great community events lately, and I'm truly grateful to our dedicated partners who help us make these exciting and accessible activities possible year-round.



### Promoting an Eco-Friendly Future

In an effort to help the community recycle rainwater and old electronics, I hosted my annual Rain Barrel Giveaway and E-Waste Collection Event. Working alongside the NYC Department of Environmental Protection, we distributed 196 rain barrels, and collected 9,815 pounds of e-waste materials from 173 households.



### Marching Against Domestic Violence

During Domestic Violence Awareness Month, my office joined the Korean American Family Service Center and community members to rally and empower survivors. I stand in solidarity with survivors, always recognizing their strength and resilience, and encourage you to help raise awareness year-round.

### **Celebrating Mid-Autumn Festival**

The Mid-Autumn Festival is a time for families to come together for festive gatherings, lighting of paper lanterns, and indulging in the traditional mooncake. ### Honoring Community Trailblazers

I had the incredible privilege of attending several street dedication ceremonies this Fall for "Rabbi Simcha Krauss Way" on 169th Street and Jewel Avenue and "Marc Haken Way" on Francis Lewis Boulevard and 204th Street.

Rabbi Krauss was a champion for women, establishing a rabbinical court to support agunot and advocating for education.

Marc Haken was a tenacious civic leader, serving for decades on Community Board 8 and Friends of Cunningham Park.

Their enthusiastic love of learning, forceful advocacy for others, and compassionate values are something to commemorate. Both legacies will have a lasting, profound impact in our community, continuing to transform lives for generations to come.

### **Standing With Israel**

On October 7th, over 1,400 men, women, children, and entire families were slaughtered by Hamas in Israel. As of this writing, many innocent civilians – including babies and Holocaust survivors – are still being held hostage. This massacre happened thousands of miles away, but it happened to us too. Israelis deserve to live securely, and Palestinians deserve leadership that chooses peace.

Since then, the rise of antisemitism and antisemitic acts in NY is unprecedented. The hate we've seen on our streets, in classrooms and on social media poses a danger to the safety of all New Yorkers. Let us be very clear: never again is now and I will continue to do everything I can to address the spike in hate and ensure that New York responds unequivocally.



# **REPRESENTING YOU IN ALBANY**



### **Keeping Kids Safe Online**

Governor Kathy Hochul, Attorney General Letitia James, State Senator Andrew Gounardes, and I have announced new legislation to regulate unhealthy social media practices and support the digital well-being of our kids (A8148 and A8149).

Recent research has shown devastating mental health effects associated with children and young adults' excessive social media use, including increased rates of depression, anxiety, suicidal ideation, and self-harm. The Stop Addictive Feeds Exploitation for Kids Act and the New York Child Data Protection Act would hold social media companies accountable for their actions and ensure that our children can navigate the social media landscape safely, without compromising their privacy.



## Protecting New York College Students

It was a privilege to join Governor Hochul and my colleagues in government when she signed legislation to protect New York's college students from hate (A3694A). Under this new law, colleges must publish information about hate crimes occurring on their campuses and establish protocols for thorough investigations. It also requires colleges to inform incoming students about their hate crime prevention measures. This law is crucial in ensuring the safety and well-being of our college students, fostering transparency and responsibility in reporting, and actively working to combat hate in all its forms.

### Making Lunar New Year and Diwali School Holidays

Governor Hochul has officially established Lunar New Year and Diwali as school holidays this year! I am proud to have helped advocate for these bills alongside my colleagues (A7768, A7769). I have persistently championed this cause, and now it has become a reality for New York families. This groundbreaking move positions New York as the pioneer state in honoring cultural heritage and inclusion!



### **Regulating Harmful Diet Supplements**

Governor Hochul signed legislation to prohibit the sale of under-regulated diet pills and weight loss supplements to children in New York (A5610). State Senator Shelley Mayer and I worked together to restrict retailers and delivery sellers from selling products that are linked to severe liver damage, eating disorders, and poor mental health to minors.

This newly enacted law establishes age verification guidelines for retailers and delivery sellers, preventing the exposure of our children to unhealthy weight control behaviors and safeguarding their overall well-being.
