My office has worked hard to address transportation issues across Assembly District 31, including a district-wide bus tour, a rally to fix the MTA, and new legislation to revitalize the dollar van industry. Southeast Queens is largely a "transit desert," where residents may need to walk at least 15 minutes or catch a ride to the nearest subway or bus stop. Riders also face a longer, more expensive commute, transferring to multiple subways or buses to reach their final destination.
