The 2022-23 state budget provides:

- **\$2.2 billion** for property tax rebate checks
- **\$585 million** to suspend the state gas tax through the end of the year
- **\$475 million** for an additional Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit payment
- **\$250 million** to help New Yorkers catch up on utility bills
- **\$162 million** to accelerate middle-class tax cuts
