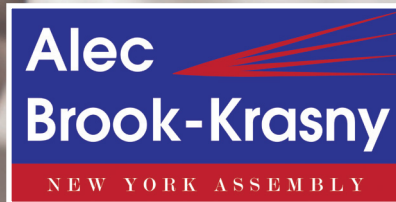

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# A Healthy Life Should Be Affordable

*“Across our city, New Yorkers feel as though rising costs are crushing them, simply for wanting to live a healthy life. That’s why I’m working in Albany to bring down the cost of health care and expand access for working families and seniors.”*

## That’s Why Alec Supports Policies That Would:

- **EMPOWER SAVINGS FOR CONSUMERS:** Establish the New York Health Care Savings Act, which authorizes the creation of health care savings accounts to allow residents to save money for the payment of qualified health care-related expenses. (A.9384)
- **ENHANCE OUTREACH:** Increase grants to health marketplace navigators in areas of the state with uninsured rates among low-income individuals that are higher than the state average. (A.9405)
- **EASE ENROLLMENT:** Create a program within the Department of Health to assist individuals without employer-sponsored coverage with enrolling in coverage through state income tax filings and allow for expanded special enrollment periods for first-time enrollees and individuals enrolling through the tax filing program. (A.9378)
- **INCREASE ACCESS FOR EMPLOYEES:** Enact the Small Business Health Plan Act, which provides small businesses opportunities to provide health insurance to owners and employees. (A.10904)
