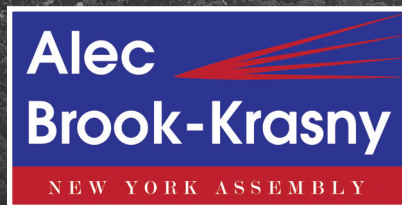

Alec Supports Policies That Would:

- Eliminate sales tax on dozens of everyday items for two years, including (but not limited to) gasoline, personal care products, housekeeping supplies and prepared foods. (A.7417)
- Eliminate taxes on overtime. (A.8965)
- Eliminate taxes on tips. (A.5856-A)
- Expand the New York State value of the Earned Income Tax Credit from 30% to 45% of the federal amount and offer the credit as installment payments instead of a lump sum when filing income taxes. (A.2498)
