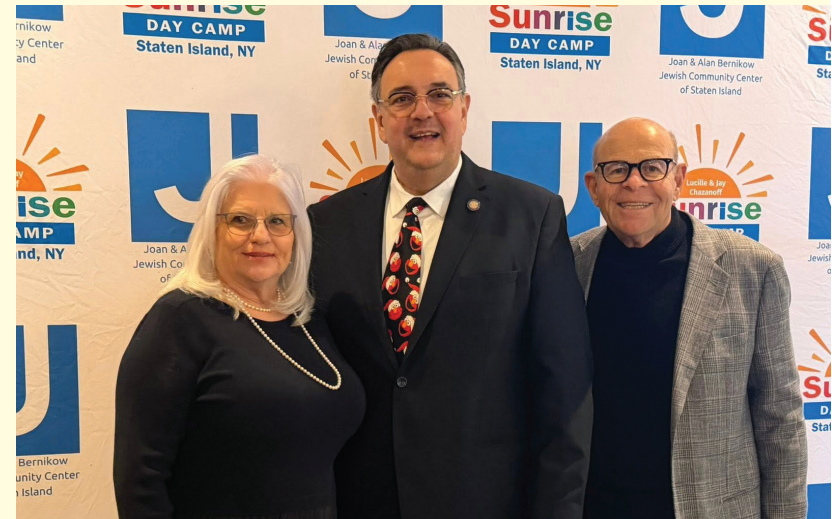
Funding Staten Island Community Organizations
