On Saturday I will be participating in a multi-community Hurricane Ida Clean-up with locations in Mamaroneck, Port Chester, Rye Brook and the City of Rye. The signup information is organized by the Town of Rye and is included below.

This newsletter also includes information for local Arts organizations and artists interested in grant funding. During the state budget process we were able to provide ArtsWestchester \$1 million in state funding for local grants to help ReStart the Arts emerging from the pandemic.

Also included is information from New York State on a variety of small business workshop and grant opportunities. Again, many of these resources were supplemented through my efforts in the budget process. I serve on an Assembly Task Force on post pandemic economic recovery.

Below you will find updated vaccine information for adults and for children ages 5-11. Guidance and availability information will continue to be updated in the upcoming weeks.

This past week Governor Hochul signed my <u>legislation</u> to extend the ability of villages to manage the processing of unpaid property taxes, an important tool for village financial management. The original reform was passed decades ago and I have sponsored this renewal legislation previously to protect this tool important to villages around the state.

New Arts Grants Opportunities Now Available

I am thrilled to announce a new funding opportunity of \$1 million dollars made available through the 2021-2022 NY state budget called "ReStart the Arts" that will be administered by ArtsWestchester to support arts and cultural organizations in Westchester and Rockland counties. I have been a long-time advocate for art organization funding. In this year's state budget we included this special funding for ArtsWestchester to assist art organizations seeking to emerge from the limitations caused these groups suffered during the pandemic.

ReStart funds will help arts and cultural organizations engage the talented artists and creative workers who are essential to the recovery of the nonprofit cultural sector. Applications will be available on the <u>Submittable</u> site in November 2021 and due on Thursday, December 16, 2021, in order to be eligible for consideration.

Organizations may apply for a fixed amount between \$2,500 to \$25,000. Priority will be given to proposals that emphasize the hiring of creative professionals in the realization of the project and those that incorporate a community engagement component. Secondary priority is given towards projects that engage creative professionals in efforts to rebuild audiences.

<u>ArtsWestchester</u> staff will host information sessions in November and conduct ongoing technical assistance sessions, by appointment, to facilitate the application and review the process.

Expanded Eligibility for the COVID-19 Pandemic Small Business Recovery Grant Program

The \$800 million program was created to provide flexible grant assistance to currently viable small businesses, micro-businesses and for-profit independent arts and cultural organizations in the State of New York who have experienced economic hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Businesses with revenues up to \$2.5 million, up from the previous threshold of \$500,000, are eligible for grants and are now encouraged to apply.
- The limitation for businesses that received Federal Paycheck Protection
 Program loans has been increased from \$100,000 to \$250,000.

Westchester County Department of Health will be holding **Pfizer vaccine booster clinics**, by appointment only, every Wednesday and Thursday, 9:00 am to 12:00 pm, at 134 Court Street in White Plains. To be eligible to **receive a Pfizer booster dose**, you must have completed your original Pfizer vaccine series at least six months ago and you must fall into one of the following categories:

- 18+ who lives or works in a high-risk setting
- 18+ with <u>underlying medical conditions</u>
- 65 years and older
