The NYS budget delivered nearly \$1 million<sup>2</sup> in aid for local governments to help ease the burden on property taxpayers. In addition, Slater directed \$50,000<sup>7</sup> for the Putnam County Veterans Museum in Kent.

**Infrastructure** Assemblyman Matt Slater helped deliver millions in state funding to repave roadways across Putnam County and reduce the cost to town government. This also included major investments to repair Rte. 301 in Patterson, Rte. 22 in Southeast<sup>8</sup> and Rte. 52 in Kent/Carmel.<sup>9</sup>

**Libraries** Assemblyman Slater provided over \$258,000 to upgrade computers and technology, improve bathrooms and community spaces and expand collections at libraries in Patterson, Kent, Putnam Valley, Brewster, Mahopac and Carmel.<sup>3</sup>

**Veterans** Assemblyman Slater secured \$75,000 for roof and window repairs and other improvements at VFW halls in Mahopac.<sup>4</sup>

**Law Enforcement** Assemblyman Slater helped provide more than \$600,000<sup>5</sup> for local police in Kent, Carmel and the Village of Brewster, including funding for an advanced speed monitoring system.
