- Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly (EISEP): Assemblywoman Gunther supported funding for this program to help older residents remain in their homes. It provides individuals living at home with non-medical services such as personal care, adult day care, transportation assistance and support services such as case management and non-institutional respite. Individuals aged 60 or older who require living assistance and are ineligible for these services under Medicaid may qualify for EISEP. #### Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

HEAP can help you save on electricity, propane, natural gas, wood, oil, kerosene and other heating fuels. Cash grants will be made available to those who need help paying their heating bills based on income, the home's primary fuel source and the number and ages of household members. HEAP will also allocate up to \$6,000 to help low-income homeowners repair or replace furnaces, boilers, or other direct heating equipment.

Low-income homeowners and those over 60 years old who pay their own heating bill may be eligible. To determine if you qualify in Sullivan County, call **845-807-0142**. In Orange County, call **845-346-1120**. HEAP enrollment began November 16<sup>th</sup> and the program works on a first come, first serve basis.

## **Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage (EPIC)**

The EPIC program can cut the cost of prescription drugs, making medications more affordable for seniors. All EPIC fee and deductible plans have been replaced by one level of coverage for all participants. EPIC only assists with prescription drugs during a coverage gap and for medication on participants' Part D plan.

To be eligible, an applicant must be a New York resident older than 65 and have an annual income of under \$35,000 (single) or \$50,000 (married).
