Assemblymember Phil Steck:

Check if you're eligible for **HEAP** benefits today

The Home Energy Assistance Program (**HEAP**) can help eligible New Yorkers heat and cool their homes. Eligibility and benefit amounts are based on income, household size, the primary heating source and the presence of a household member who is aged 60 or older or permanently disabled.

If you are eligible, you may receive one regular **HEAP** benefit per year. Those who are in danger of running out of fuel or having their utility service shut off may also be eligible for emergency HEAP benefits.



HEAP may be able to help if you heat your home with:

- ✓ Electricity
- ✓ Natural Gas
- ✓ Oil
- ✓ Coal
- ✓ Propane
- ✓ Wood/Wood Pellets
- ✓ Kerosene
- ✓ Corn
