# ASSEMBLYMEMBER PHIL STECK IS SEEKING YOUR HELP TO END LOCAL CELLULAR DEAD ZONES

Assemblymember Steck has reached out to the FCC and is working with multiple major cell phone carriers to find solutions to the lack of cell coverage in Colonie. Local emergency services should not be reporting dropped calls, cutting off residents in potentially life-threatening situations.

Town of Colonie residents can report dead zones in cell coverage to [concerns110@nyassembly.gov](mailto:concerns110@nyassembly.gov). Reports should include the wireless carrier and approximate address of the dead zone or spotty cell service.
