## Assemblywoman Carrie Woerner: SUPPORTING OUR EMS AGENCIES

- Allow air transport ambulances to carry blood and emergency medical technicians on board to perform transfusions (A.256I-B)
- Allow claims for death or disability benefits due to vascular rupture, which was inspired by the tragic death of Whitehall Volunteer Fire Company Chief James Brooks (A.6767-A)
- Regulate the use of flame-retardant chemicals in upholstered furniture, mattresses and electronics to reduce the impact of fires (A.5418-B)

Assemblywoman Woerner introduced and is continuing to advocate for a bill that would increase the tax credit for volunteer firefighters and EMS members from \$200 to \$1,200 (A.886).

Assemblywoman Woerner also helped pass legislation that designates emergency responders, dispatchers and operators as "first responders in communications" and provides benefits for people who were employed in qualified service during the World Trade Center rescue, recovery and cleanup operations.
