Whether it's helping our veterans, supporting our regional economy, helping neighbors in need after severe storm damage, speaking up for our first responders, or helping generations of families in Central New York and the Southern Tier, I am always here to help you. Also, if you see me out and about, be sure to say hi.

Defending those who served:

Our veterans of all ages are facing different challenges. I voted yes to include those who were part of the Reserve Forces Act in the "Cold War Veterans" real property tax exemption program (A.7466); include career members of the armed forces as eligible for the Veterans Alternative Tax Exemption program (A.6055-A); and require coroners to document incidences of veteran suicide so the state can better track this growing problem among our veterans (A.3237-A).

Protecting your years of hard work:

I opposed \$4.4 billion in new taxes (A.3009-C), (A.1248-A).

Improving our community safety:

I voted for the creation of the New York State Rural Ambulance Services Task Force to evaluate and improve access to rural ambulance care (A.1561-C).

Supporting unique care needs for families:


Pressures from various family stressors have left many children in the care of grandparents, other family members, or neighbors. I voted to strengthen the position of "kinship caregivers," which allow more people to care for a loved one's child, keeping them out of the foster care system, and to qualify for financial assistance when caring for minors and to help keep siblings together (A.3496).

Additionally, I voted for a number of bills to improve long-term care, including a bill to extend the services of the state Long-Term Care Ombudsman to include those receiving managed long-term care (A.7022), the creation of the Elder Abuse Enhanced Multidisciplinary Team (A.7634), and establishment of the "Reimagining Long-Term Care Task Force," which will lead to improvements for the long-term care system (A.3922-A).
