STAR vs. Enhanced STAR

Senior citizens receiving Enhanced STAR are not affected by the new registration requirement. Seniors must, however, take steps to ensure that they continue to receive Enhanced STAR.

Seniors receiving Enhanced STAR who reside outside of New York City must continue to:

- apply annually, or
- participate in the Income Verification Program.

STAR ELIGIBILITY

The eligibility criteria are the same for both the STAR credit and the STAR property tax exemption. You can't receive both the credit and the exemption.

Eligible homeowners

Basic STAR Enhanced STAR

Residency	You must own your home and it must be your primary residence.	You must own your home and it must be your primary residence.
Age	No age restriction	65 or older For jointly owned property, only one spouse or sibling must be at least 65 by December 31 of the year when the exemption will begin.
Income	\$500,000 or less The income limit applies to the combined incomes of only the owners and owners' spouses who reside at the property.	For 2016 benefits, \$84,550 or less. For 2017, \$86,000 or less. The income limit applies to all owners and any owner's spouse who resides at the property.

EPIC

The Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage (EPIC) program is a New York State program for seniors administered by the Department of Health. To enroll in EPIC you must:

- 1. Be a NYS resident age 65 or older;
- 2. Have an annual income below \$75,000 if single, or below \$100,000 if married;
- 3. Be enrolled or be eligible to be enrolled in Medicare Part D; and
- 4. Not receive full Medicaid benefits.

HEALTH CARE PROXY

New York Health Care Proxy laws allow state residents to appoint trusted family members or close friends to make healthcare decisions for them if they become incapacitated or unable to direct their own course of treatments.
