Protecting those who protect our communities!

Assemblyman Brian Miller would like to thank all first responders for their hard work, as he knows the past two years have been especially difficult. While these brave individuals have been protecting our communities, Brian has been fighting in Albany to protect them. He has supported policies to:

- **Make offenses against law enforcement officers, emergency medical personnel, or firefighters hate crimes (A.3824);**
- **Study the issues rural communities have with emergency response and disaster preparedness (A.6023);**
- **Increase the total weekly disability benefits for volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance workers who were injured on or after July 1, 2021 from \$400 to \$650 (A.1324-A);**
- **Create a rural ambulance services task force to study and improve ambulance services in rural communities (A.1561-C);**
- **Establish a 25-year retirement plan for firefighters who were employed by the Division of Military and Naval Affairs (A.6062);**
- **Give volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers free access to New York State parks (A.7278 of 2020); and**
- **Provide emergency medical technicians and paramedics with special license plates and eliminate the annual service charge for such plates (A.3884 & A.3844).**
