SAID YES TO MUCH-NEEDED TAX RELIEF for hardworking New Yorkers, INCLUDING (A.9009-C):

- ✓ Homeowners TAX REBATE CHECKS program: \$2.2 billion

- ✓ GAS TAX SUSPENSION: \$585 million
