COVID-19 has only exacerbated the need for affordable, high-quality child care. Families who are currently receiving child care scholarships through the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act are strongly encouraged to apply for this new scholarship. Essential Worker Child Care Scholarship

The Office of Children and Family Services is providing **\$25 million** in child care scholarships for children of essential workers.

Eligible workers with children ages six weeks to 12 years old whose income is less than 300% of the federal poverty level will receive assistance for child care costs through this initiative.



As the COVID-19 state of emergency comes to an end, the time has come to renew your license! New Yorkers who don't have recent vision test results can self-certify that their vision is acceptable and provide additional documentation at a later date. Visit <http://dmv.ny.gov/driver-license/how-renew-license> to learn more.

As New York regains a sense of normalcy, the time has come for those with driver's licenses or permits that expired on or after March 1, 2020, to renew them.

If your license expires between March 1, 2020 and Aug. 31, 2021, you can renew your license online now and submit a vision test to the DMV within a year of your renewal.
