York, with the Syracuse area alone seeing a 40% increase in victims killed by gun violence over the last five years¹, and a 13% increase in violent crime over the last five years.² I've fought back against the skyrocket in crime by sponsoring bills such as:

- ✔ Strengthening criminal penalties for shooting into a crowded space **(A.4259)**
- ✔ Creating the felony crime of resisting arrest for repeat resisting arrest offenders **(A.4324)**
- ✔ Strengthening penalties for passing a stopped school bus and causing injury or death **(A.5507)**
- ✔ Legislation to combat child abuse, sex abuse, and murder at the request of local district attorneys and child advocates **(A.5754)**
