During this past legislative session, I fought for policies that would improve our communities. In this year's budget, I advocated for increased library funding and welcomed state library leaders, including Greece Public Library Guthrie Cassie Director and NYLA Executive Director AnnaLee Dragon, to Albany. Additionally, I called on New York State to help local governments make their neighborhood playgrounds more accessible, alongside Greece resident Santii Patel.
