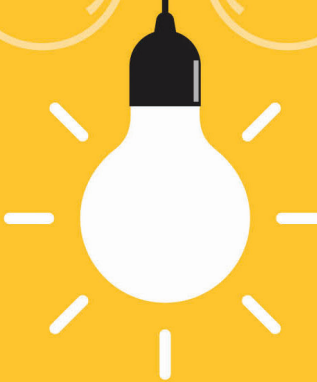

- ✓ Any unused NYSERDA funds would be returned to customers (A.8876-A)
- ✓ Would restore your choice to use natural gas and other heating options (A.6796)
- ✓ Would require a full cost-benefit analysis on renewable energy with regular updates to determine if it is worth continuing to pursue (A.6260)
- ✓ Would require monthly reports on the costs and benefits of mandated NYS energy programs to be fully transparent about the impact on your bills (A.6152-A)
- ✓ Directs state agencies to plan and expand the use of hydrogen energy as part of New York's energy strategy (A.11582)
