Assemblymember Harry Bronson: State budget increases funding for Rochester schools

SUPPORTING STUDENTS FROM PRE-K TO GRADUATION DAY

To support Rochester students, Harry Bronson helped pass a budget that:

- Provides \$84 million in new state funding and \$284 million in federal funding for the Rochester (ity School District, which will prevent devastating budget cuts
- Allocates \$36 million for universal pre-K in the RCSD an \$8 million increase over last year
- · Continues funding for the RCSD monitor which has provided much-needed oversight and guidance
- Assists students who have disproportionately suffered from the pandemic and have lacked essential access to the internet through digital inclusion programs

INVESTING IN HIGHER EDUCATION

Harry Bronson fought to ensure the state spending plan rejected proposed tuition increases at SVNY schools and included a \$30 million increase for college opportunity programs.

To further help students and higher education institutions, the budget provides:

- \$100 million to SUNY for expansion projects
- \$88 million to increase the maximum Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) award by \$500 for a
 maximum total award of \$5,665
- \$35 million in unrestricted aid to private higher education institutions
- \$20 million in federal funds for each of the next two years for scholarships to cover non-tuition expenses such as housing, meal plans and books and help close the affordability gap
