Highlights of 2017:

- 1 Voted to strip corrupt lawmakers of their pensions (A.1749)
- 2 Sponsored and helped pass a \$45 million relief package for victims of Lake Ontario's historic flooding (A.8013-A)
- **3** Hosted his 10th Annual Patriot Trip to Washington D.C. as a way to give back to local veterans and their family members
- Sponsored the "2017 Charitable Gaming Act," which allows nonprofits, churches, fire departments, Rotary and Kiwanis Clubs, and charitable organizations to sell raffles online and accept debit and credit cards as payments (A.6095-A)
- 6 Helped obtain \$200 million in BRIDGE-NY and PAVE-NY funds and \$65 million in Extreme Winter Recovery funds to help us repair and resurface roads, bridges and highways (A.3004-D)
- 6 Sponsored a bill to repeal the SAFE-Act outside of New York City (A.6140)
- Worked to achieve \$2.5 billion in clean water infrastructure funding to repair and replace dangerous lead pipes in our schools, protect aquifers, and help local governments upgrade wastewater treatment capabilities (A.3004-D)
- 8 \$32.9 million in Agriculture Local Assistance Programs, a \$2 million increase (A.3003-D)
