Assemblymember Wallace on how the state budget supports Western New Yorkers and their families

- Cuts middle-class income tax rates from 6.45 percent to 5.5 percent for households earning between \$40,000 and \$150,000

- Provides vital funding to assist municipalities with extreme weather recovery
- Promotes economic development initiatives in Western
 New York
- Supports families by investing \$80 million in child care initiatives
- Funds community programs that support veterans and their families
