Assemblymember Wallace is fighting against sexual harassment in the workplace

New protections under state law:

- Directs state agencies to **develop model policies to help employers combat sexual harassment**
- Ensures **timely and confidential investigations** of harassment complaints
- **Prohibits confidentiality clauses in settlements** except when requested by the victim
- **Bans mandatory arbitration agreements** for claims of sexual harassment
- **Holds public employees found guilty of harassment responsible** for payments
