Improved Griffith Park

\$355,000 for new disability-accessible bathrooms, resurfaced pickleball and hockey courts, sidewalks, playground equipment and a splash pad in Griffith Park *

Helped first responders

\$185,000 for two specialized devices to extinguish electric vehicle battery fires, fire hoses, a thermal imaging device to locate hot spots and victims in structure fires and a Jaws of Life tool to extricate auto crash victims *

Supported community events

\$15,000 to ensure the continuation of Sloan's summer concert series and other popular community events this past summer *

Assisted schools

Helped secure over \$21 million in education aid for the Cheektowaga-Sloan School District in the 2023-24 New York State Budget, a 12.28% increase from last year.

Maintained critical Infrastructure

Invested **\$8,600,000** in state aid to reline sewers and reduce pollution flowing into local waterways *
