The rich and powerful need to play by the same rules as everyone else:

- Put corrupt politicians in jail and throw away the key
- Establish **term limits for legislative leaders** and committee chairs (A.5864)
- Eliminate bid-rigging so every business has the same opportunities, not just those who cozy up to state leaders (A.5864)
- Ban corrupt politicians from continuing to run for office (A.5864)
- Reduce campaign contribution rates to keep 'big money' and special interest groups out of politics (A.5864)
- Stop politicians from using their position to solicit cash bribes and donations from those looking for government influence
- Harsher penalties for officials who use state resources to fund their political campaigns (A. 6810)
