CONSUMER CHOICE & LOWER COSTS

SMALL BUSINESS HEALTH PLAN ACT (A.10904)
 Would create a new class of health insurance for small businesses that is exempt from most insurance requirements.

HEALTH CARE SAVINGS ACCOUNT (A.9384)
 Would create a New York State Health Care Savings Program allowing residents to set aside money in tax-advantaged accounts for qualified medical expenses.

SAFEGUARDS TO PROTECT RATEPAYERS FROM WASTE AND FRAUD

CRACKING DOWN ON MEDICAID FRAUD (A.6351)
 This bill would help counties and New York City recover more taxpayer dollars from successful Medicaid fraud prosecutions, creating stronger incentives to root out waste, fraud, and abuse.

HEALTH INSURANCE COST STUDY (A.10788)
 This bill would direct the state to study New York's mandated health insurance coverages, compare them to other states, and identify how these requirements affect costs, access, and consumer choice.

PROTECT MEDICAID PATIENTS (A.9312)
 Seeks to increase transparency in Medicaid managed care network reviews and safeguard continuity of care when providers leave networks, ensuring taxpayer dollars result in real access to doctors.
