ORAL TESTIMONY BY INVITATION ONLY

On March 7, 2020, a state of emergency was declared in New York State due to the novel coronavirus, COVID-19. Institutions of higher education across the state sent students home and transitioned from in-person classroom instruction to distance learning. The closure of college campuses due to COVID-19 has resulted in a loss of access to libraries, lecture halls, academic labs, and other educational tools. Layoffs and job losses resulting from COVID-19 have also severely impacted students and their families financially, putting students' ability to complete their education into question.

In accordance with Federal and State guidelines, institutions are currently formulating reopening plans for the upcoming academic year. As institutions plan to reopen, they are dealing with the difficulty of planning for students, faculty and staff to return to campus safely, while at the same time managing an unknown fiscal situation and potentially steep enrollment declines.

The Committees seek to receive input from stakeholders across the State on the academic and financial impact COVID-19 has had and will continue to have on institutions of higher education as it relates to enrollment, affordability, and the transition to distance learning. Additionally, the Committees welcome testimony on the reopening steps colleges and universities are taking to ensure the health and safety of students, faculty and staff for the 2020-21 academic year.

Persons invited to present pertinent testimony to the Committees at the above hearing should complete and return the enclosed reply form as soon as possible. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified of means by which to testify and/or in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation.

Oral testimony will be limited to five minutes' duration. In preparing the order of witnesses, the Committees will attempt to accommodate individual requests to speak at particular times in view of special circumstances. These requests should be made on the attached reply form or communicated to Committee staff as early as possible.

Attendees and participants at any legislative public hearing should be aware that these proceedings are video recorded. Their likenesses may be included in any video coverage shown on television or the internet. In order to further publicize these hearings, please inform interested parties and organizations of the Committee's interest in hearing testimony from all sources.

In order to meet the needs of those who may have a disability, the Legislature, in accordance with its policy of non-discrimination on the basis of disability, as well as the 1990 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), has made its facilities and services available to all individuals with disabilities. For individuals with disabilities, accommodations will be provided, upon reasonable request, to afford such individuals access and admission to Assembly facilities and activities.
